

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COLUMBIA COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

**In the Matter of Designation of Certain)
County Roads for Unlicensed ORV Use) Resolution 2010-12**

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2010-01 allows for the use by unlicensed ORV of designated roads, pursuant to RCW 46.09.180; and

WHEREAS, RCW 46.09.180 allows Columbia County to designate for ORV use roads which connect the City of Dayton to ORV Recreation Facilities; and

WHEREAS, RCW 46.09.020 (16) includes roads designated by the United States Forest Service as multiple-use corridors maintained by the United States Forest Service for recreational use by motorized vehicles; and

WHEREAS, Columbia County may designate or undesignated such roads as they deem fit for ORV access to ORV Recreational Facilities; and

WHEREAS, several Columbia County roads qualify for such designation; and

WHEREAS, members of the public have petitioned for access pursuant to RCW 46.09.180, and

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Columbia County Public Works Department will maintain a listing of such designated roads, post the same on its website, and properly sign such roads as the Columbia County Board of Commissioners may designate for ORV use.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that on this date the Columbia County Board of Commissioners do hereby designate the following roads for ORV use to access the United States Forest Service ORV Recreational Facilities:

Eckler Mountain Road	Road No. 91240	MP 0.184 to MP 16.084
Maloney Mountain Road	Road No. 19310	MP 8.396 to MP 10.104


